GO TO **MENU>PLUGINS>GREEN BUTTON** TO DOWNLOAD PLUGINS

INSTALL **e2iplayer-dependencies** from **EXTENSIONS**

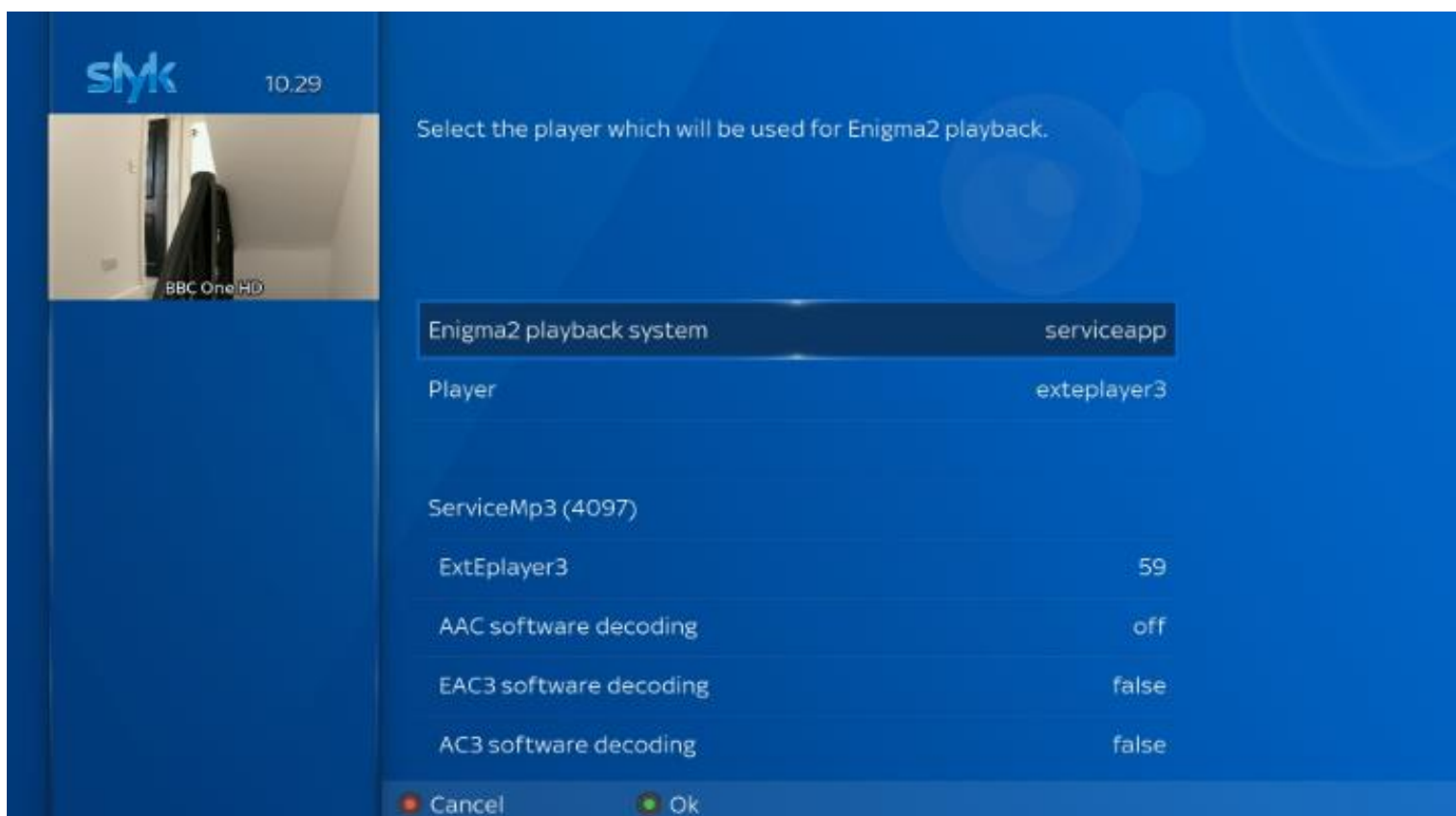
INSTALL **serviceapp** FROM **SYSTEMPLUGINS**

EXIT AND RESTART GUI

WHEN RESTARTED **MENU>SETUP>SYSTEM>SERVICEAPP**

CHANGE ENIGMA2 PLAYBACK SYSTEM TO **SERVICEAPP**

CHANGE PLAYER TO **EXTEPLAYER3**



YOU WILL NEED TO RESTART GUI FOR CHANGES TO TAKE EFFECT.

USING PUTTY, CONNECT TO YOUR RECEIVER AND LOGIN WITH 'root'

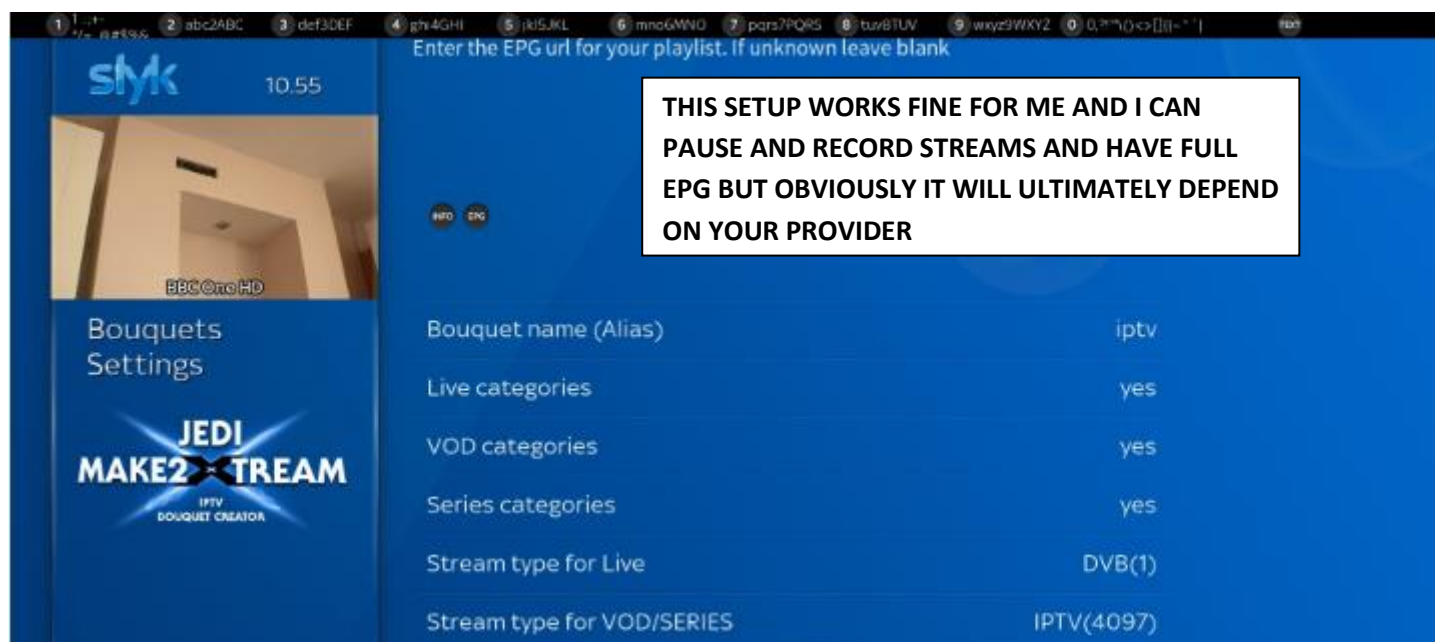
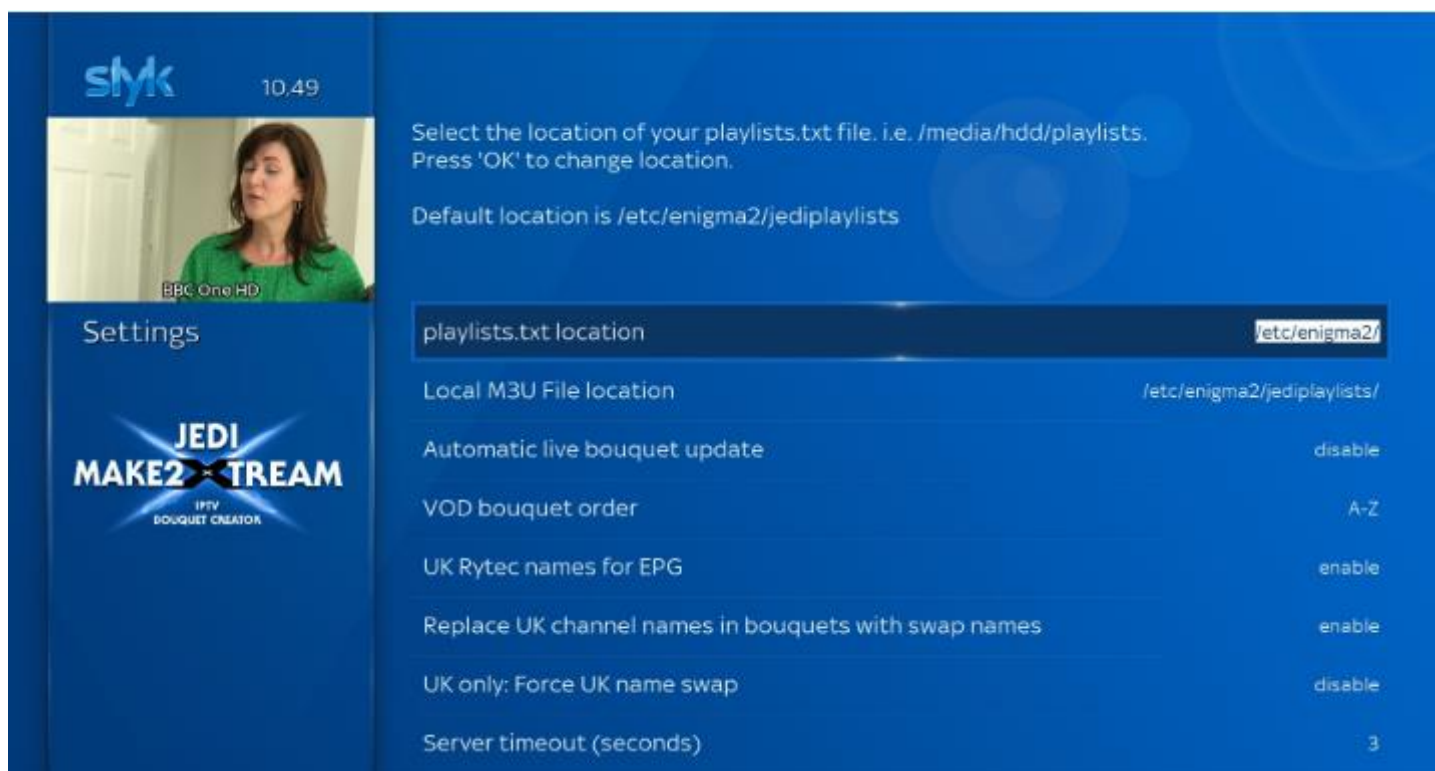
COPY AND PASTE THIS SCRIPT BY RIGHT CLICKING IN PUTTY AND FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS:

wget --no-check-certificate -O IPTV.sh https://raw.githubusercontent.com/davesayers2014/plugins/master/iptv.sh && chmod +x IPTV.sh && ./IPTV.sh
```

MENU>PLUGINS>JediMakerXtream AND FOLLOW KIDDAC'S INSTRUCTIONS.

JediMakerXtream will generate an IPTV source in EPGimport sources. Make sure this is selected as a source and I also select Rytek IPTV XMLTV (xz)
